Metrocrest Services named Non-profit of the Year

At the Governor's Small Business Forum held October 22nd at Coyote Ridge Golf Club in Carrollton, Metrocrest Services received the State of Texas Small Business Award in the nonprofit category. The forum was sponsored by the Texas Governor's Office, Texas Workforce Commission, and the City of Carrollton Economic Development Department.

Metrocrest Services provides programs for families, individuals and seniors that foster independence and lead to self-sufficiency. Last year the agency assisted 19,409 individuals and their food programs resulted in 664,423 meals for low-income families in Carrollton, Farmers Branch, Coppell, Addison and the Denton County portion of the City of Dallas.

"We are honored to be recognized," stated Metrocrest Services CEO Tracy Eubanks. "For over forty years Metrocrest Services has worked to serve those in need. Local community partners and over 4,000 volunteers a year help us reach those who struggle to become financially independent."

The 501(c)(3) nonprofit currently provides a wide range of services including financial literacy training, employment assistance, rent and utility bill aid, transportation and home-delivered meals for seniors, seasonal programs, and operates a 1,200 square foot food pantry serving over 100 families per week.
